TOURNAMENT DETAILS

Venue: Blue Canyon Country Club, Lakes Course

Date: Sunday 10th February 2019

Time: Shotgun Start 12:00am. (Noon)

ADMINISTRATION

The Tournament Committee (TC) will be responsible for the administration of the tournament and reserve the right to limit the number of entries or modify the rules of play in any way considered desirable. The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews (R&A) and the United States Golf Association (USGA) 2019 and the Local Rules of Blue Canyon Country Club (BCCC).

RULES OF PLAY

1. The Tournament shall be played over one round of 18 holes, on the Lakes Course. Consisting of Men, Ladies, and Senior. Using stroke play the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A, USGA and the Local Rules of BCCC.
2. Complaints, protests and disputes shall be referred immediately to the TC, whose decision on all matters will be final. The Course Marshals shall assist the TC in overseeing Pace of Play on the course.
3. Tournament Divisions will be calculated to achieve equitable divisional numbers.

Men Division A	0-9	Blue
Men Division B	10-17	Blue
Men Division C	18-24	White
Men Division D	25-36	White
Senior Division	36 or Below	Yellow
Ladies Division	36 or Below	Red



4. **Scoring in maximum score will be set for two times par in each hole.** A player who does not hole out under the rules for any reason get the maximum score for the hole. To help pace of play, players are encouraged to stop playing a hole when their score has reached the maximum.
5. To searching for the winner
 - Overall Low Gross: A winner of the overall low gross will be determined by the player with the lowest gross score of all the players.
 - Overall Low Net: A winner of the overall low net will be determined by using system 36.
 - Low Gross Division A, B, C, D, Ladies and Senior: The winners of the Low Gross divisions are determined by the player with the lowest gross score of his or her division.
 - Low Net Division A, B, C, D, Ladies and Senior: The winners of the low net in each divisions are determined by using System 36.
6. In the event of a tie, all ties in all divisions Net and Gross. The count back shall be used as follows until there is one player clear.
 1. Best back 9
 2. Best last 6 holes
 3. Best last 3 holes
 4. Best on hole # 18
7. Please allow enough time to make sure you arrive on the tee with time to spare. If you are up to 5 minutes late after your tee time you will be given a 2 stroke penalty. Any player that does not tee off within 5 minutes of his or her start time will be disqualified.
8. Play shall be begun on the sounding of one long blast of the siren at 12:00 noon sharp. The TC reserves the right to determine and alter starting times. Players are to report to the official registration at the Tournament office for the correct Tee or Rules and Regulation for the day at least 10 minutes before their starting time.
9. If the TC decides there is or weather conditions mean that 18 holes can't be completed by all groups then the tournament will based on the numbers of holes completed by all the groups.
10. Completion time of one round (18 holes) for any group shall be 4. 1/2 hours and this shall be the guideline for assessment of slow play. The Pace of Play for each hole is fixed and if a group is observed to be out of position – i.e. lost substantial ground on the group ahead or in the case of the first group has taken in the opinion of the TC an unacceptable amount of time to play any part of the golf course- the group shall be liable to be timed. Players should notify the course marshal if they feel other players in their flight or ahead of their flight are causing “Slow Play”.



11. When a group is being timed, any player who takes more than 40 seconds shall be deemed to have a “Bad Time.” Course Marshalls are authorized to issue warnings to slow players and players who fail to heed such warnings may be penalized.

- First Bad Time - Warning from Course Marshall
- Second Bad Time - One-stroke penalty
- Third Bad Time - Two-stroke penalty
- Fourth Bad Time - Disqualification

Bad times shall be carried forward in the round, even if the group subsequently arrives back in position or within time, as may be specified by the TC. All timings will be preformed by TC - appointed Referees/Timers.

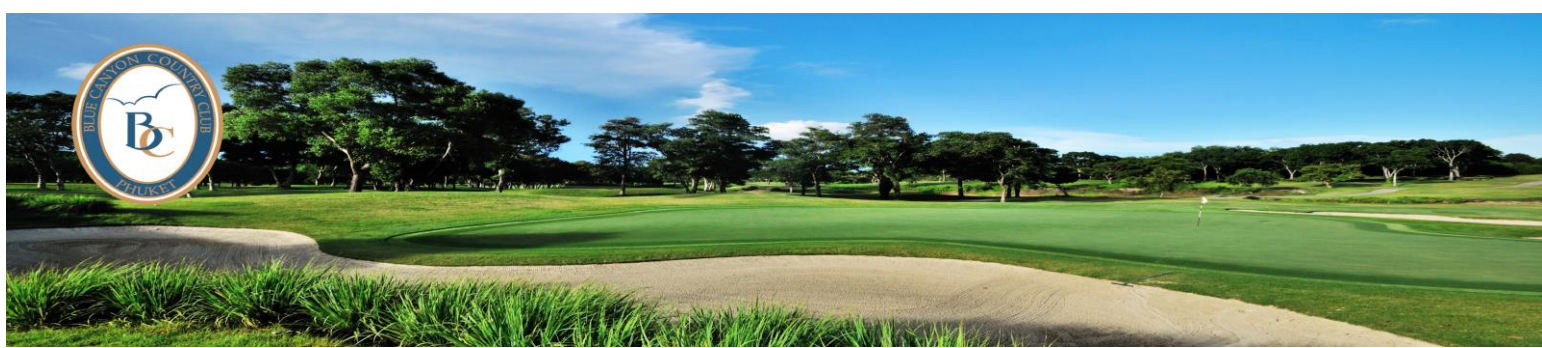

12. Play shall be suspended on the sounding of one long blast of the siren. Players must mark there ball and stop play immediately and shall not resume play until the TC orders a resumption of play with the second long blast of the siren.
